## **1. CT** [50 pts]

Indicate what these print. Place your answers (and nothing else) in the box next to each block of code.

#### 2. Free Response: Dot around Dot [50 pts]

Write an app such that:

- 1. At first, a cyan dot of radius 20 is drawn so it is centered vertically but its left edge is at the left edge of the canvas. Also, a smaller black dot of radius 5 is drawn at "12 o'clock" on the cyan circle -- that is, so the center of the black dot is at the top of the cyan circle.
- 2. Every 1/20th second, the black dot moves around the cyan dot, with its center always on the edge (or perimeter) of the cyan dot, changing its position by 10 degrees. At first this motion is clockwise, but each time the user presses any key, the motion toggles between clockwise and counter-clockwise.
- 3. Every 1/4 second, the cyan dot moves 10 pixels to the right, until it hits the right edge of the canvas, then it moves 10 pixels to the left until it hits the left edge of the canvas, at which point the cyan dot no longer moves.
  - Hint: you should set app.stepsPerSecond to 20, but only have the cyan dot move on some but not all calls to onStep.
- 4. Note that the black dot always moves around the cyan dot, even as the cyan dot itself is moving. Also, the black dot continues to move, even after the cyan dot stops moving.

Hint: to solve this, you will need to write onAppStart, redrawAll, onStep, and onKeyPress. Also, you may assume the canvas is 400x400, and that all necessary imports are already included for you.
